Your Attitude - Your Choice!

All of us have had situations that we have found ourselves in which we didn't like. Circumstances that happen to us through no fault of our own, decisions we have made that may have gone wrong, and sometimes life in general just throws us a curve ball - a medical condition, the death of family or friends, difficulties at work.

And how are we to respond?

We can become inward looking and despondent about what is happening to ourselves, or to look up and out to God choosing to make the best of the challenges before us.

Essentially that was what Jeremiah was telling his people.

They had a choice - to continue to lament and be dejected or to get on with life making the best of it. Either way their circumstances wouldn't change, but their attitude toward the situation would, and their attitude to God would too.

We see Paul in our reading from 2 Timothy dealing with these same issues.

He is in prison for preaching the gospel. He could have become bitter over this, but instead he keeps his thoughts on what is important, trusting God to help him in his circumstances. Paul speaks from first-hand experience of joys and challenges in his life. He chose to lift his attitude above the difficulties and to concentrate on God's blessings instead of lamenting his predicament.

The same applies to us.

God has given us the ability to choose our attitude and He encourages us to choose to focus on Him and be thankful throughout our lives.

So, the question for us to ponder this week is: What is your attitude to life like? - remembering that your attitude is your choice and you can't blame anyone else for it.
