3. The individual ministry/mission project. That the worker builds relationships and trust and is bold in proclaiming the gospel by action and word. That the ministry be fruitful and God's favour rest on each worker.
4. The mission worker's families (as family commitments can often distract people from their work). Strong support of each other, suitable facilities, and friendships for children and, as families, remain strong in the Lord.
5. The people working on the mission project. Knowing God's timing for field work, development and refreshing, always staying close to Him. Strong emotional, financial and prayer support from their home base/church.
6. Knox Morrinsville as we partner in missions. That we remain active in our support for the mission projects through prayer, communications and practical help.

If it helps, you can follow a format similar to the prayer below and pick and mix from the various prayer points above. Here is an example:
